Excellent Learning & Teaching

By the end of the 2019 our school will have grown the engagement, progress and achievement of each student in literacy.

Link to Strategic plan objective

Our vision for learning and well-being provides stakeholders with a coherent pedagogical framework and a safe, nurturing environment that encourages and challenges all to achieve their potential.

Activities:

- Staff PD in January with teachers to implement school wide Spelling Scope & Sequence and create a resource bank to support Spelling
- Construction of a whole school Grammar Scope & Sequence
- Explicit teaching about audience and purpose in Writing and also continue to access '7Steps to Writing' resources from 2018
- Ensuring 'Bump it Up' walls are co-constructed with students displaying annotated examples of writing traits
- Engage Literacy consultant to conduct PD workshop in Spelling & Writing
- Continue with school short tem planning cycles/release teachers each term for planning with PLL & APRE
- Schedule partnered Learning Walks & Talks

In 2019 our school will identify as an 'Emerging' school in numeracy with a focus upon the Four Key Dimensions Framework.

 Data to identify targeted students and focus areas

- Leadership to formally analyse student attendance data twice each term. Share attendance data in newsletters and discuss with students in their relevant cluster meetings.
